September 5, 1918 - April 12, 2012

Sutton resident Sophia "Sophie" Trautman, passed away Thursday, April 12, 2012, at the Sutton Community Home in Sutton, NE, at age of 93 years, 7 months, and 1 week.

Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m., Monday, April 16, 2012, at Emmanuel Reformed Church in Sutton, NE with Rev. Joe Vusich officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery in Sutton, NE.
