Sutton resident Adeline Irene Ochsner, 86, passed away Saturday, May 23, 2020, at the Sutton Community Home in Sutton, NE.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m., Thursday, May 28, 2020, at Hope Reformed Church in Sutton, NE with Rev. Scott Henry officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery in Sutton, NE. Services will be live-streamed from the Hope Reformed Church Facebook page beginning at 10:30 a.m. Due to the Directed Health Measure party(s) must maintain a minimum of 6 feet of separation and consist of a household unit or individual at both the funeral service and graveside service. Visitation will be Wednesday, from 1 p.m. - 8 p.m., at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton. We will be following the CDC guidelines of 10 people gathering at a time for visitation.
