Burton Royce Wells, 84, died in Lincoln, Nebraska, on June 2, 2013. Born near Sutton (Clay Co.), NE, on February 7, 1929, to Rose Ruby Amelia (Hultquist) and William Robert Wells. Attended Rural District 9, near Saronville (Clay Co.), NE through the eighth grade. Graduated in 1946 from Sutton High School. He served in the Army from 1951 to 1953; with the 114th QM Graves Registration Company in Korea during the Korean War, attaining the rank of Corporal.
