Grafton, NE, resident David S. Stuckey, 68, passed away Sunday, April 5, 2026, at the Henderson Health Care Hospital in Henderson, NE.

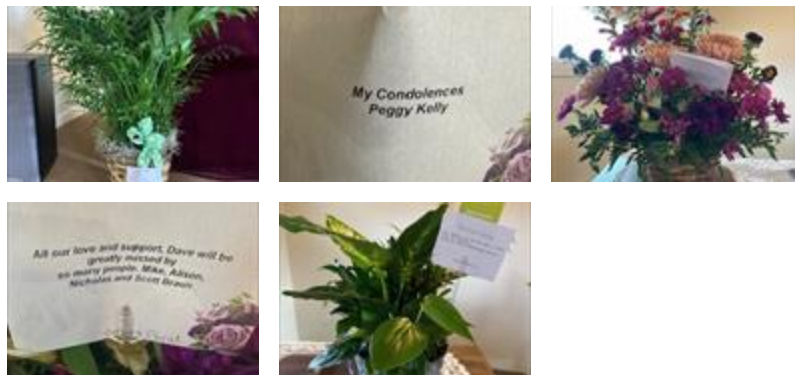
