Seward resident Don Darrel Kauk, 72, passed away Tuesday, December 20, 2022, at his home in Seward.

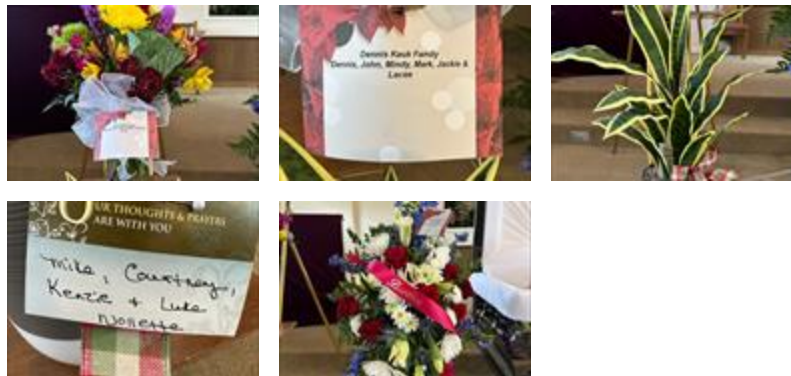
