Former Fairfield resident, Erma Mae (Davis) (Trobough) Hoins, 92, passed away Tuesday, September 22, 2020, at Perkins Pavilion Good Samaritan Society-Hastings Village in Hastings.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11:00 a.m., Friday, September 25, 2020, at the Fairfield Community Presbyterian Church in Fairfield with Pastors Ivan and Joyce Dean officiating. Interment will follow at the Fairfield Cemetery in Fairfield. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service at the church.

Gordon died in October of 2012.

Erma was a hard worker, always busy on the farm with her large garden, canning, animals, 4-H, cooking, baking, and always somehow making the

ordinary seem fun. She and Gordon loved dancing, traveling, and much laughter. When asked her favorite memories of the farm, she loved the weiner roasts with friends and family. Her least favorite was the ornery roosters. Her smile and genuine loving and caring for others will be truly missed.
