Clay Center, NE resident Florine Gertrude Iverson, 91, passed away Tuesday, May 26, 2020, at Harvard Rest Haven in Harvard, NE.

A private family Rosary will be prayed Monday, June 1, 2020, at McLaughlin Funeral Chapel in Clay Center, NE. A private Mass of Christian Burial will be conducted Tuesday, June 2, 2020, at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Harvard, NE with Father Christophe Stoley officiating. where Richard worked at the Meat Animal Research Center and Florine worked in the cafeteria at Clay Center School until her retirement in 1993.

She was a member of the St. Joseph Catholic Church and Altar Society.
