Former Grafton resident, Janice "Jan" Mae Ulmer, 81, passed away Sunday, January 26, 2020, at Legacy Square in Henderson, NE.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m., Saturday, February 1, 2020, at Hope Reformed Church with Rev. Scott Henry officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery. Visitation will be one hour prior to the service at the church.
