Clay Center, NE., resident Joyce E. Holeman, 74, passed away Saturday, September 25, 2021, at Bryan Medical Center West Campus in Lincoln, NE.

Memorial services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m., Monday, October 18, 2021, at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE., with Rev. David Feddern officiating. Inurnment will follow at the Clay Center Cemetery in Clay Center, NE. In honoring her wish to be cremated there will not be a visitation or viewing.

as a bank teller, and later for the U.S. government at the ASCS office.

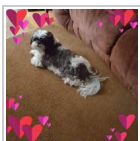
