Lincoln resident, Judy Lynne Becker, 69, passed away Friday, March 23, 2018, at St. Elizabeth Medical Center in Lincoln, NE.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11:00 a.m., Friday, March 30, 2018, at the Federated Church in Sutton, NE with Rev. Mary Scott officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery in Sutton, NE. Visitation with the family present will be held on Thursday, from 5 p.m. - 8 p.m., at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE.
