Sutton resident Kourtney Ann Robbins, 22, passed away Sunday, October 20, 2013, as a result of an automobile accident.

Services will be 2:00 p.m., Thursday, October 24, 2013, at the Federated Church in Sutton, NE with Pastors Eric Biehl and Harry Cross officiating.
