Sutton resident, Louise Hofmann, 96, passed away Friday, July 8, 2016, at the Sutton Community Home in Sutton, NE.

Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m., Monday, July 11, 2016, at Sutton Memorial Chapel with the Free German Reformed Salem Church Elders officiating. Interment will follow at the Free German Reformed Salem Church Cemetery. Visitation will be Sunday, from 2 p.m. - 8 p.m., at Sutton Memorial Chapel.
