November 19, 1919 - November 27, 2015

Former Sutton resident, Louise Stevens, 96, died Friday, November 27, 2015, at Holmes Lake Rehabilitation and Care Center, Lincoln, NE.

Funeral services will be 1:30 p.m., Wednesday, December 2, 2015, at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE with the Free German Reformed Salem Church Elders officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery. Visitation will be Tuesday, from 1 - 8 p.m., at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE.
