Sutton resident, Lucille E. Perrien, 89, passed away Thursday, March 30, 2017, at the Sutton Community Home in Sutton, NE.

Funeral services will be held at 10:00 a.m., Monday, April 3, 2017, at the Federated Church in Sutton, NE with Pastor Mary Scott officiating.
