Clay Center resident, Lynn A. Hagemeyer, 85, passed away Wednesday, March 29, 2017, at Fairview Manor in Fairmont, NE.

Funeral services will be held at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, April 1, 2017, at Grace Lutheran Church in Geneva, NE with Pastor Stephen Kruschel officiating. Interment will follow at the Clay Center Cemetery in Clay Center, NE, with military rites by the American Legion Mills-Schroder Post #81.
