Sutton resident Margaret "Marge" E. Ham, 89, passed away Tuesday, October 20, 2020, at her home in Sutton.

Funeral services will be conducted at 2:00 p.m., Saturday, October 24, 2020, at the Federated Church in Sutton, NE with Pastor Mary Scott officiating. Interment will follow at the United Methodist Cemetery near Saronville, NE. Visitation will be Friday, from 1 p.m. - 8 p.m., with the family present from 5 p.m. - 7 p.m., at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE.
