Glenvil, Ne resident Marlyn Duane Fike, Sr., 83, passed away Wednesday, November 30, 2022, at Mary Lanning Healthcare in Hastings, NE.

Memorial services will be conducted at 10:00 a.m., Thursday, December 8, 2022, at Immanuel Lutheran Church in Glenvil, NE with Pastor Jonathan Jehorek officiating.
