Sutton, NE resident Martin Nuss, 86, passed away Monday, April 20, 2020, at the Henderson Health Care Hospital in Henderson, NE.

Due to the COVID-19 restrictions, a private family funeral service will be conducted Thursday, April 23, 2020, at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE with the Free German Reformed Salem Church Elders officiating. Services will be live-streamed from Sutton Memorial Chapel's Facebook page beginning at 10:00 a.m. Private interment will follow at the Free German Reformed Salem Church Cemetery near Sutton, NE. Visitation will be Wednesday, from 4 p.m. - 8 p.m., at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE.

Martin Nuss was born December 11, 1933, on the family farm in Clay County near Stockham, NE to Ephraim K., Sr. and Rosa (Griess) Nuss. He received his formal education at a couple of county schools and Stockham Public School.

Martin was married to Suzanne Huber on June 10, 1954, in Geneva, NE, they celebrated their 65th-anniversary last year in June. There were 9 children brought together by this union. Martin raised crops on his farm and also

owned a dairy farm. After retiring from farming, he worked at York Mfg., Sutton Lumber Yard, and Central Nebraska Wood Preservers. He enjoyed visiting with the customers at work.

Martin enjoyed hunting, bowling, coin collecting, Nebraska Football and Volleyball, golf, croquet, and hanging out with family and friends. He taught his family how to butcher hogs and handed down many of his recipes, still being used today. He was a member of the Stockham Jaycees, Stockham Boosters, and the Free German Reformed Salem Church.
