Former Sutton resident Nathalie A. Green, 76, died Tuesday, Dec. 6, 2011, at the Legacy Terrace in Lincoln.

Services are 2 p.m. Saturday at the Federated Church in Sutton with Pastor Eric Biehl officiating. Burial is at Sutton Cemetery in Sutton.
