Sutton resident Norma Ruth Ochsner, 88, passed away Wednesday, August 20, 2014, at the Harvard Rest Haven in Harvard, NE.

Funeral services will be 10:30 a.m., Tuesday, August 26, 2014, at Emmanuel Reformed Church in Sutton, NE with Rev. Joe Vusich officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery. 1950, Norma and Leo were blessed with a son, Raymond where they worked and lived as good Christians until Leo's sudden death in 1989.
