Former Grafton, NE resident Patrick James Keenan, 51, passed away Tuesday, February 24, 2015, at his home in Sutton, NE.

Funeral services will be 11:00 a.m., Monday, March 2, 2015, at Zion Evangelical Lutheran Church in Sutton, NE with Rev. Judy Nuss officiating. Cremation will follow the service. Visitation will be Sunday, from 1 p.m. - 8 p.m., with the family present from 5 p.m. - 7 p.m., at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, NE.
