April 9, 1925 - July 23, 2013

Phyllis E. Hultine of Sutton, Nebraska passed away on Tuesday, July 23, 2013 at the Memorial Hospital in Aurora, Nebraska at the age of 88 years, 3 months and 14 days.

Funeral services for Phyllis were held on Friday, July 26, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. at the Zion Lutheran Church in Sutton, Nebraska with Pastor Judy Nuss officiating the service.
