Sutton resident Ruben Hofmann, 82 passed away Saturday, October 17, 2015, at the Henderson Community Hospital in Henderson, Nebraska

Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, October 20, 2015, at Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, Nebraska with the Free German Reformed Salem Church Elders officiating. Interment will follow at the Free German Reformed Salem Church Cemetery near Sutton, Nebraska. Visitation will be Monday, October 19, 2015 from 1 ~ 8 p.m., with family greeting friends from 5 ~ 7 p.m., at the Sutton Memorial Chapel in Sutton, Nebraska.
