Sutton resident Shirley Jean Syring, 83, passed away Thursday, December 6, 2012, at Independent House Memory Care in Lincoln, NE.

Funeral services will be 1:30 p.m., Monday, December 10, 2012, at the Federated Church in Sutton, NE with Rev. Eric Biehl officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery in Sutton, NE.
