



## Twila Mae Mack

Former Clay Center resident, Twila Mae Mack, 85, passed away Wednesday, April 15, 2015, at the Parson's House on Eagle Run in Omaha, NE.

Funeral services will be 2:00 p.m., Thursday, April 23, 2015, at Zion Lutheran Church in Clay Center, NE with Rev. Del Klover officiating. She was an active member of the Chamber of Commerce, Mrs. CCs, United Methodist women, and the American Legion.

After retirement she enjoyed quilting and continued to share her baked goods with friends and family. Harlan and Twila traveled to Germany, cruised to

Alaska, and spent their winters in Apache Junction, AZ. They enjoyed time with their daughters and families and have eight grandchildren and five great grandchildren. They moved from the farm to a home in Clay Center in 2005. She is preceded in death by Harlan in 2010 and moved to Omaha where she was closer to her daughters. Her daughters believe Twila's greatest achievement in life was to help them to achieve their career goals and to set the example for "being the best that you can be."
