Sutton, NE resident Victor L. Kathol, 77, passed away Wednesday, November 14, 2018, at Mary Lanning Healthcare in Hastings, NE.

Rosary will be prayed at 7:00 p.m., Sunday, November 18, 2018, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Sutton, NE. Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 10:30 a.m., Monday, November 19, 2018, at St. Mary's Catholic Church with Father Michael Zimmer officiating. Vic received his education at Holy Trinity High School in Hartington, Nebraska with continued education at St. Benedictine College and Creighton University. Vic married Lorraine Rynaski on April 27, 1963, at St. Thomas More Catholic Church in Omaha, Nebraska. A. O. Smith Harvestore employed Vic for more than 15 years. He was then self-employed for the later years of his life, logging several thousand miles with Aspen Carrier.
