



## Virginia (Thompson) Hultman

August 12, 1930 - January 5, 2014

Sutton resident Virginia Lee (Thompson) Hultman, 83, passed away Sunday, January 5, 2014, at the Sutton Community Home in Sutton, NE.

Funeral services will be 10:00 a.m., Thursday, January 9, 2014, at the Federated Church in Sutton, NE with Rev. Harry Cross officiating. Interment will follow at the Sutton Cemetery in Sutton, NE. She was married to Earl Hultman on June 9, 1957, in Fairmont, NE., two children Connie Sue and James Lee were born to this union.
